


Planning your best presentation

- Start by choosing a topic-
 - Topics should be timely, interesting, and something you enjoy.
 - Choose something that might not be the most popular, but something that you can relate to.
- Narrow down that topic to something more specific
 - Think through the main points you want to cover.
 - Think through ideas for how you would structure an intro and an ending.

Preparing for your best presentation

- Writing your presentation
 - Outline
 - Add the meat to the outline
 - Refine and perfect
- Use Credible Sources
 - Find sources that have credible information, not opinions
 - Make sure to find the source, your source quoted.
- Prepare your visual aides (educational presentations)
 - What visuals will be most effective to drive home your points?
 - Don't add something that makes no sense to your presentation

Practicing your best presentation

- Refine and perfect your voice
 - Practice in front of people, pets, and the mirror
- Plan your movement & gestures
 - How will you use your room?
 - What will you do with your hands? Gestures should add to the presentation, not distract from it.
- Perfect your timing and speed.
 - Are you speaking too quickly? Too slowly?
- Practice answering questions.
 - Be sure to know your resources! Anticipate any question that could be asked and know how to answer it.



Present your best presentation

PRESENT

What is your "day-of" routine? How do you handle the questions?

- What do you wear?
- What is in your emergency kit?
- What do you do right before the competition starts?
- What are your best presentation tips?
- Questions:
 - Listen to the questions and answer what is actually being asked, not what you think they need to hear.

Troubleshoot your presentation

TROUBLESHOOTING

What do you do when things do not go as planned?

- What do you do when things go wrong?
- What do you do if you blank on your presentation?
- What do you do if you didn't hear or understand the questions that were asked?
- What other things can wrong & how do you prepare for those?

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
