After the 60-hour period has ended, the late fee will increase to \$25 per book. Lunch: Lunch and refreshments will be provided and included in the \$15.00 per person registration fee. Checks should be made payable to Hill County 4-H and should be paid at the door. Receipts will be available at that time. Please do not send checks to the District office ahead of time. Preparation of Books before Judging:

1. On the front cover of the Recordbook folder, attach a 3x5 index card (stapled or with a binder clip; no paper clips, please) with the following information PRINTED:
