Recognize your Volunteers

Recognizing volunteers is crucial for keeping your 4-H club thriving. Here are straightforward and effective ways for 4-H club managers to show appreciation:

- <u>Personalized Thank-You notes:</u> Send handwritten notes and small gifts (like 4-H branded items or local gift cards) to make volunteers feel truly appreciated.
- **Volunteer Appreciation Events**: Organize annual dinners, picnics, or recognition segments in meetings to publicly celebrate their contributions.
- Awards and Certificates: Hand out awards or certificates during events to formally recognize the hard work and dedication of volunteers.
- <u>Social Media Shout-Outs:</u> Feature volunteers on the club's social media or in local newspapers to highlight their efforts to the broader community.
- <u>Volunteer of the Month/Year</u>: Establish these awards to continuously motivate and recognize outstanding volunteer commitment.
